CRIMINAL MISCHIEF: Between August 18th and 19th someone forced open the door of the concessions stand at the baseball fields of Laurel Acres Park. The door frame was broken but nothing was reported stolen.

ARREST: On August 19th at 10:29 pm Mount Laurel Police conducted a motor vehicle stop on Crow's Nest Court near Centerton Road. During the stop officers arrested David J. Jones, age 18, Evesham, NJ. He was charged with possession of less than 50 grams of marijuana and possession of drug paraphernalia. He was released pending a court hearing.

CRIMINAL MISCHIEF/THEFT: On August 20th someone used a drill to break into two vending machines at the Wyndham Hotel and steal an undetermined amount of cash.

ARREST: On July 17th a resident reported that they were a victim of credit card fraud. The investigation revealed that Thomas A. Helvig Jr., age 35, of Mount Laurel NJ made numerous fraudulent transactions over the course of totaling over \$13,000.00. He was charged with credit card fraud, impersonation, theft by deception and theft of credit cards. Bail was set at \$50,000.00 with no 10% option. He was served the charges on August 23rd at the Burlington County Jail where he was being held on unrelated charges.

ARREST: At 8:28 pm on August 23rd Mount Laurel Police responded to the parking lot of 720 S. Church Street for a suspicious person report. Officers found John J. Horay, age 37, of Maple Shade, NJ sitting in a vehicle that didn't belong to him. He appeared to be under the influence of an intoxicating substance. It was also discovered that he shoplifted \$14.87 worth of merchandise from the Wawa. Horay was charged with shoplifting and released pending a court hearing.

ARREST: At 4:34 am on August 24th Mount Laurel Police responded to Centerton Road near Crow's Nest Court for a disturbance. As a result of the investigation officers arrested Kelsey K. Landolf, age 22, of Merchantville, NJ. She was charged with possession of heroin and possession of prescription drugs without a prescription. She was released pending a court hearing.

CRIMINAL MISCHIEF: Between August 23rd and 24th someone broke windows and damaged a door of two businesses on the 100 block of West Park Drive.

ARREST: At 6:42 pm on August 24th Mount Laurel Police responded to a hotel on the 1100 block of Route 73 for a customer dispute. During the investigation officers arrested Heather M. Eichmann, age 30, of West Grove, PA. She was wanted out of Coatesville, PA for drug charges. She was charged with being a fugitive from justice with bail set at \$5,000.00 no 10% option. She was committed to the Burlington County Jail.

OVERDOSE REVERSAL: At 4:25 pm Mount Laurel Police responded to the report of an unresponsive person at a residence on the 100 block of Hastings Way. Officers determined the subject had overdosed on heroin and they administered Narcan. The subject was revived and transported to the hospital by Mount Laurel EMS.
