THEFT: An employee of a business at 1120 Route 73 reported that her cell phone was stolen after she On February 20th at 7:00 pm an accidentally left it in a rest room. The phone had been left unattended for approximately 30 minutes.

ARREST: On February 21st at 2:10 am Mount Laurel Police conducted a motor vehicle stop on Route 38 near Ark Road. During the stop officers arrested Rhasheed S. Gray, age 40, of Mount Holly, NJ. He was charged with driving while intoxicated and released pending a court hearing.

ARREST: On February 21st at 11:03 am Mount Laurel Police responded to Wegman's on Centerton Road for the report of a man groping female customers. The investigation revealed that a male suspect had purposely touched the buttocks of a 17 year old female in the store. Officers arrested Jeffrey A. Torres Jr., age 27, of Trenton, NJ. He was charged with endangering the welfare of a child and criminal sexual contact. He also had active criminal warrants for his arrest out of jurisdictions in Mercer County. Bail was set at \$50,000.00 with no ten percent option and he was committed to the Burlington County Jail.

ARREST: On February 21st at 5:00 pm Mount Laurel Police responded to the Home Depot on Nixon Drive for a shoplifting complaint. A suspect stole \$189.00 worth of merchandise and then attempted to return it for a refund. Officers arrested Giomanni A. Davie, age 25, Camden, NJ. He was charged with shoplifting and released pending a court hearing.

ARREST: On February 21st at 6:30 pm Mount Laurel Police conducted a motor vehicle stop on Route 38 near Dearborne Circle. During the stop officers arrested Latoya T. Stephens, age 38, of Maple Shade, NJ. She was charged with driving while intoxicated and released pending a court hearing.
