ARREST: On January 27th at 3:15 pm Mount Laurel Police responded to Ulta on Nixon Drive for the report of a woman who fled the store after shoplifting \$95.00 worth of perfume. She was located by officers walking on Nixon Drive. Officers arrested Chantae T. Holmes, age 30, of Philadelphia, PA. She was charged with shoplifting and possession of oxycodone pills. Bail was set at \$7,500.00 with no ten percent option and she was committed to the Burlington County Jail.

ARREST: On January 29th at 2:25 am Mount Laurel Police conducted a motor vehicle stop on Century Parkway near Fellowship Road. During the stop officers arrested Kenneth W.
