THEFT of MISLAID PROPERTY: A victim reported that she accidentally left her wallet in the waiting room of LabCorp on Century Parkway on February 5th between 12:00 pm and 1:00 pm. When she returned to the business her wallet containing cash, credit cards, and identification was gone.

CREDIT CARD THEFT/FRAUD: A victim reported that on February 5th at approximately 5:30 pm credit cards were stolen from her purse while she dined at a restaurant on Nixon Drive. The credit cards were then fraudulently used at several stores in the area.

CRIMINAL MISCHIEF: A victim reported that someone scratched her vehicle sometime between February 4th and 5th while it was parked on the 4000 block of Greenwich Lane.

ARREST: On February 7th at 1:07 am Mount Laurel Police responded to a hotel on Route 73 for an intoxicated male causing a disturbance. Officers arrested Curtis E. Ray, age 26, of Philadelphia, PA. He was charged with disorderly conduct and released pending a court hearing. At 6:39 am Mount Laurel Police were called out to the hotel again for a disturbance between Mr. Ray and the hotel staff. Officers arrested Mr. Ray again. He was charged with disorderly conduct and resisting arrest. Bail was set at \$5,000.00 with no ten percent option. He was committed to the Burlington County Jail.

THEFT: On February 7th at 3:29 am a taxi driver reported that he drove three men from Philadelphia to the 100 block of Oakmont Road in Mount Laurel. On arrival the three men ran from the taxi failing to pay their \$45.00 fair.
