**ARREST:** Between November 8<sup>th</sup> and November 14<sup>th</sup> three customers of The Home Depot on Nixon Drive had tools stolen from their work trucks that were parked in the parking lot. In total over \$11,000.00 in tools were stolen. Officers were able to identify a suspect and the vehicle he was operating. At 8:05 am on November 15<sup>th</sup> an officer located the suspect in his vehicle parked on Lenola Road behind the Shoprite on Nixon Drive. Mark Leander Zachary, age 58, Philadelphia, PA was arrested and charged with two counts of burglary, three counts of theft, and possession of crack cocaine. Bail was set at \$35,000.00 with no 10% option and he was committed to the Burlington County Jail.

**LEWDNESS:** A resident of the 1800 block of Augusta Circle reported that at 5:15 pm on November 11<sup>th</sup> she noticed the motion activated lights on the back of her residence go on. She looked out on her porch and saw a man standing there exposing his genitalia. He ran off when she called for her husband. The suspect was described as a white male, 6' tall, curly blond hair, mustache, in his late 20's.

**ARREST:** At 2:14 pm on November 13<sup>th</sup> Mount Laurel Police responded to a residence on Woodlark Drive for a disturbance. Officers conducted a motor vehicle stop of a vehicle driving erratically on Woodlark Drive and arrested Nicholas J. Dinucci 3<sup>rd</sup>, age 23, of Mount Laurel. He was charged with driving under the influence and released pending a court hearing.

**ARREST:** At 3:57 pm on November 13<sup>th</sup> Mount Laurel Police conducted a motor vehicle stop on Route 38 near I295. During the stop officers arrested Karen G. Nolan, age 61, of Mantua, NJ. She was charged with possession of less than 50grams of marijuana and possession of drug paraphernalia. She was released pending a court hearing.

**CREDIT CARD FRAUD:** On November 14<sup>th</sup> an employee of Applebee's restaurant on the 1100 block of Route 73 reported that orders for food to go were purchased with fraudulent credit cards.

**ARREST:** At 4:14 pm on November 15<sup>th</sup> Mount Laurel Police responded to TJ Maxx on Centerton Road for a shoplifting in progress. A responding officer located the suspect vehicle on Marne Highway at Young Avenue. He attempted to stop the vehicle but the suspects refused to stop and instead drove back to TJ Maxx. One of the suspects exited the car and took the \$980.00 worth of coats they had stolen back into the store. Officers arrested Tonya W. Jordan, age 49, of Willingboro, NJ and Louisa M. Hawkins, age 52, of Cinnaminson, NJ. Jordan was charged with eluding and shoplifting. Hawkins was charged with shoplifting. Both were released pending a court hearing.

**ARREST:** At 10:11 pm on November 16<sup>th</sup> Mount Laurel Police conducted a motor vehicle stop on Route 73 near I295. During the stop officers arrested Kalid A. Abdalazez, age 20, of Burlington, NJ. He was charged with possession of less than 50 grams of marijuana and released pending a court hearing.

**ARREST:** At 1:41 am on November 16<sup>th</sup> Mount Laurel Police conducted a motor vehicle stop on Route 73 near I295. During the stop officers arrested Samarth Rangampally, age 25, of Trenton, NJ. He was charged with driving while intoxicated and released pending a court hearing.

**ARREST:** In October of 2016 the Mount Laurel Police began investigating suspected prostitution activity at the Therapy U Plus massage parlor at 4201 Church Road. On November 17<sup>th</sup> a search warrant was executed resulting in the arrest of two employees. Sin Yong Kang, age 60, of Newport News, VA was charged with operating a house of prostitution and promoting prostitution, and An Yujung, 49, of Flushing, NY was charged with soliciting prostitution. Both women were released pending a court hearing.
