THEFT: At approximately 1:45 pm on October 16th a victim had a credit card stolen from her purse while shopping at Costco on Centerton Road. Her card was then fraudulently used in another jurisdiction.

THEFT/CRIMINAL MISCHIEF: At 5:35 am on October 17th two vehicles had windows broken and wallets stolen while parked in the Future Fitness parking lot on Hovtech Boulevard. The suspect was operating a black unknown make SUV.

ARREST: At 12:25 pm on October 17th Mount Laurel Police conducted a motor vehicle stop on Larchmont Boulevard near Hainesport Road. During the stop officers arrested Kasey Kearney-Argow, age 24, of Mount Laurel. She was charged with driving while intoxicated and possession of Suboxone. She was released pending a court hearing.

ARREST: At 6:44 am on October 18th Mount Laurel Police responded to a hotel on the 1100 block of Route 73 for a disturbance. During the investigation officers arrested Emanuel Wiley, age 55, of Mount Laurel. He was charged with possession of less than 50 grams of marijuana and released pending a court hearing.

THEFT/CRIMINAL MISCHIEF: A resident of the 300 block of Willow Turn reported that during the overnight hours of October 17th into the 18th someone forced their way into his vehicle by breaking a window. The center console of the Jeep Grand Cherokee was removed and taken by the suspect.

BURGLARY: At 3:20 pm on October 18th Mount Laurel Police responded to the 500 block of South Brentwood Drive for a residential burglary in progress. A 12 year old resident reported that she was home alone when she heard a knock at the front door and the doorbell rang. She did not answer the door. A short time later a man broke the rear sliding glass door with a landscaping brick and attempted to enter the house. The girl screamed and the suspect fled without entering the house. While looking for the suspect in the neighborhood officers discovered another residence on the 500 block had been burglarized. The rear sliding glass door of that house had also been broken and entry was gained. The residents of the second house were not home at the time of the break in.

ARREST: At 11:00 pm on October 18th Mount Laurel Police responded to a hotel on Clover Road to check on the wellbeing of a guest. As a result of the investigation officers arrested four subjects for various offenses.

Ashley M. Locicero, age 27, of Manchester Township, NJ – She was arrested for an outstanding warrant and released after satisfying the warrant.

Rachel M. Vazquez, age 36, of Clemmenton, NJ - charged with engaging in prostitution, possession of drug paraphernalia and possession of crack cocaine. She was released pending a court hearing.

Nadyne Zayas, age 32, of Pine Hill, NJ -charged with possession of hypodermic needles and possession of drug paraphernalia. She was released pending a court hearing.

Karrie-Ann Puhl, age 29, of Pine Hill, NJ - charged with possession of less than 50 grams of marijuana. She was released pending a court hearing.
