THEFT: Between 7:25 pm and 8:30 pm on September 30th Samsung Galaxy 6 phone, a blue Nautica bag and black Adidas pants were stolen from an unlocked locker at the YMCA.

ARREST: At 1:09 am on October 1st Mount Laurel Police responded to Route 38 at Briggs Road for a motor vehicle crash. During the investigation officers arrested Sampson Johnson, age 44, of Browns Mills, NJ. He was charged with driving while intoxicated and released pending a court hearing.

THEFT: Between 1:20 am and 2:00 am on October 1st two victims attending an event at a hotel on the 900 block of Route 73 reported their coats and a sweater were stolen. The items had been left unattended.

THEFT: On October 3rd An employee of AAA, 4010 Dearborn Circle reported that two Snap-On Solus vehicle diagnostic scanners were stolen from the garage area of the business between July and August of this year.

THEFT: A resident on the 100 block of Elbo Lane reported that a Donald Trump campaign flag was stolen from his flag pole between October 2nd and 3rd.

THEFT: An employee of a business on the 14000 block of Commerce Drive reported her wallet was stolen from her cubical on October 3rd between 9:10 am and 1:00 pm.

ARREST: At 8:55 pm on October 3rd Mount Laurel Police conducted a motor vehicle stop on Fellowship Road at Century Parkway. When the officer approached the vehicle a rear seat passenger jumped out of the car and aggressively confronted the officer. The passenger Miguel Gonzalez, age 56, of Voorhees, NJ refused to comply with the officers and was arrested for obstructing the administration of law. Gonzalez struggled with officers as they handcuffed him. He was charged with obstruction and resisting arrest. Gonzales was released pending a court hearing.

BURGLARY: During the overnight hours of October 3rd into October 4th someone forced entry into Pancheros Mexican Grill on Dearborn Circle. The suspect(s) stole \$100.00 from a cash register.

ARREST: At 9:30 on October 4th Mount Laurel Police responded to a hotel on the 1100 block of Route 73 for a suspicious person complaint. During the investigation officers located two people in a parked vehicle preparing to use heroin. Officers arrested both subjects and charged them with possession of heroin, possession of drug paraphernalia, and possession of hypodermic syringes. They were both released pending a court hearing. Kenneth A. Megginson, age 23, of Barrington, NJ. He was charged with possession of oxycodone, possession of heroin, and possession of drug paraphernalia. Bail was set at \$16,500.00 and he was committed to the Burlington County Jail.

TERRORISTIC THREATS: At 12:30 am on October 5th Mount Laurel Police responded to the area of Brentwood Drive near Ramblewood Parkway for the report of a subject that had been robbed. The 26 year old male victim reported being chased from the parking lot of a hotel on the 1100 block of Route 73 and into a business parking lot on Rogers Walk by an unknown subject. The victim said the suspect was armed with what he believed was a handgun. The investigation determined no robbery or attempt had occurred. The incident is still under investigation.

SHOPLIFTING: At 2:55 pm Mount Laurel Police responded to the Wegmans on Centerton Road for a shoplifting complaint. It was reported that a white male subject approximately 5'08" tall, mid 20's, wearing a short sleeve flannel shirt, and a black baseball hat with a flat red brim stole \$117.00 worth of Red Bull energy drinks and other merchandise. Store loss prevention officers confronted the suspect who then turned over the merchandise. When he learned the police had been called he ran out of the store and got into a Silver Buick Lesabre driven by an unidentified female.

ARREST: At 9:06 pm on October 5th Mount Laurel Police responded to a hotel on the 1100 block of Route 73 for a disorderly person. During the investigation officers arrested Akeef C. Salley, age 27, of Bartow, FL. He was charged with possession of less than 50 grams of marijuana and possession of drug paraphernalia. He was released pending a court hearing.

THEFT: Between 7:40 pm and 8:15 pm on October 6th a cell phone was stolen from a locker at the YMCA, 59 Centerton Road. The locker had been forced open.

ARREST: At 7:00 pm on October 6th Mount Laurel Police responded to a residence on Kelly Cove to serve an arrest warrant on William R. Brennan, age 33, of Mount Laurel. He was charged with possession of prescription legend drugs and committed to the Burlington County Jail for the outstanding warrant.
