ARREST: At 10:00 pm on September 6th Mount laurel Police conducted a motor vehicle stop on Route 73 near Ramblewood Parkway. During the stop officers arrested Rosaria Branin, age 48, of Riverside, NJ for an outstanding warrant. She was also found to possess Suboxone, marijuana, and drug paraphernalia. She was charged with possession of a controlled dangerous substance, possession of less than 50 grams of marijuana, and possession of drug paraphernalia. She was turned over to another law enforcement agency for the warrant.

ARREST: On August 16, 2016 Mount Laurel Police received a report of a shoplifting that had occurred at the Wegmans on Centerton Road on August 12th. The investigation revealed that Michael R. Foglio, age 31, of Avondale, PA had shoplifted \$167.00 worth of merchandise from the store. A warrant was issued for his arrest with bail set at \$5,000.00 with no 10% option. On September 7th Foglio was arrested by New Jersey State Police during a motor vehicle stop and then turned over to Mount Laurel Police. Foglio was committed to the Burlington County Jail

FORGERY: On September 7th Mount Laurel Police received a report of an attempted forgery at the Bed Bath and Beyond on Centerton Road that occurred on September 7th. A subject attempted to make a \$540.00 purchase using counterfeit money. When the clerk told the suspect that they could not accept the currency the suspect left the store. The suspect was describe as a black male in his 40's and between 5'9" – 6' tall. He was wearing a cream colored shirt and pants with a black vest.

ARREST: On September 8th Donna Troiano, age 51, of Mount Laurel turned herself in to Mount Laurel Police and was charged with hindering the apprehension of Christopher A. Troiano, age 18, of Mount Laurel. The charges stemmed from an investigation into a reported theft that occurred in the parking lot of the CVS, 3110 Route 38, at 6:38 pm on September 3rd. On that day Christopher A. Troiano claimed his backpack was stolen by several other young males. He said the backpack contained his cell phone and debit card. During the investigation Christopher identified himself as a 17 year old juvenile with a different name. Officers spoke with Donna Troiano who also identified Christopher as the 17 year old fictitious person. Later that evening officers discovered Christopher provided a false name because he was wanted by Marple Township Police, PA for robbery. Donna Troiano was charged with hindering the apprehension of another and released pending a court hearing. Christopher Troiano was charged with 3rd degree hindering apprehension and a warrant for his arrest has been issued. As a result of the original theft report a warrant was issued for Marcellus K. Shazier, age 19, of Mount Laurel charging him with the theft of the back pack. The backpack was later located in the possession of Layne B. Modeste, age 18, of Mount Laurel. Inside the backpack police found jewelry stolen from a recent vehicle burglary on Saxony Drive. Modeste was arrested on September 5th and charged with two counts of receiving stolen property.

THEFT: A resident from the first block of Yearling Chase reported that at approximately 11:55 pm on September 7th he heard the doors of his car close. He looked out of the window and saw an unknown white male in a black t-shirt running out of his driveway. The victim discovered that the suspect stole a laptop from his unlocked vehicle.

ARREST: On September 8th Samantha D. Beale, age 28, of Woodlynne, NJ turned herself into the Camden County Sheriff's Department for an arrest warrant out of Mount Laurel. Beale was charged with shoplifting \$440.00 worth of merchandise from Wegmans on June 15, 2016. Beale was turned over to Mount Laurel Police and then committed to the Burlington County Jail.

SHOPLIFTING: Two unidentified males stole several packages of meat from the Aldi, 3105 Route 38, at 9:12 am on September 8th.

THEFT: A resident of Maple Shade reported their 1998 Honda Civic was stolen from the 400 block of Willow Turn sometime between August 15th and September 1st.

ARREST: At 12:50 pm on September 9th Mount Laurel Police responded to a hotel on the 1100 block of Route 73 to look for a wanted person. The officers arrested Jacquelly M. Sturgill, age 28, and Jessiealy C. Masmann, age 30, both of Mount Laurel. Officers discovered both subjects possessed illegal drugs. Sturgill was charged with possession of heroin and released pending a court hearing. Masmann was charged with possession of crack cocaine, possession of oxycodone, and possession of drug paraphernalia. Bail was set at \$17,500.00 no 10% option in addition to \$7,500.00 bail for outstanding warrants from several jurisdictions. She was committed to the Burlington County Jail.

ARREST: At 1:53 pm on September 9th Mount Laurel Police arrested Alexandria Diguglielmo, age 24, of Runnemede, NJ while at a hotel on the 1100 block of Route 73. She was charged with possession of heroin and released pending a court hearing.

ARREST: At 4:14 pm on September 9th Mount Laurel Police responded to the Shop Rite on Nixon Drive for a shoplifting report. During the investigation officers arrested Eduardo Mirandes, age 33, of Berlin, NJ. He was charged with shoplifting and released pending a court hearing.

ARREST: At 4:33 pm on September 10th Mount Laurel Police responded to the Wegmans on Centerton Road for a shoplifting. The suspect fled the store on foot when he was approached by store security. Officers located the suspect running on Centerton Road near Marter Avenue. He was ordered to stop but refused. Officers gave chase on foot and took him into custody. Vincent J. Taggart, age 32, of Croydon, PA was charged with obstruction of justice and shoplifting \$1092.00 worth of razor blades and teeth whitening strips. Bail was set at \$10,000.00 no 10% option. He was also found to be wanted out of Montgomery County PA and the Board of Probation and Parole, Harrisburg, PA. Taggart was charged with being a fugitive from justice with bail set at \$15,000.00 no 10% option. He was committed to the Burlington County Jail.
